

Satin Balls - The Original Recipe

The following recipe was sent to **Wellpet** by Diana Carreon, R.N.,C. It quickly became one of the most requested posts on Wellpet.

We use satin balls to feed a dog that has gone off of their diet.

Ingredients

- 10 pounds hamburger meat [the cheapest kind]
- 1 lg. box of Total cereal
- 1 lg. box oatmeal
- 1 jar of wheat germ
- 1 1/4 cup veg oil
- 1 1/4 cup of unsulfured molasses
- 10 raw eggs AND shells
- 10 envelopes of unflavored gelatin
- pinch of salt

Mix all ingredients together, much like you would a meatloaf.

Roll into 2" by 1" meat balls and freeze in quart size freezer bags, it helps to separate the balls with paper towels.

Thaw as needed and feed raw!
